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Dear parents and guardians,

This brochure contains all important information regarding

- admission to and enrollment in 5th grade at a secondary school for universitybound students (*Gymnasium*), a secondary school offering general education (*Realschule*), a non-academic secondary school (*Mittelschule*) or a specialty school (*Schule besonderer Art*).
- enrollment at a secondary school focused on business and economics (*Wirtschaftsschule*).
- requirements, focus areas and qualifications offered by municipal technical schools (*Fachoberschulen, FOS*) or vocational schools (*Berufsoberschulen, BOS*).
- requirements and enrollment for evening courses at a municipal academic secondary school (*Abendgymnasium*), at the municipal *Munichkolleg* or the municipal *Franz-Auweck-Abendrealschule*, which all offer second chance educational opportunities (*Schulen des Zweiten Bildungswegs*).

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
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


Admission to and enrollment in 5th grade

Your child has the following options:





Please enroll your child at the school to which he or she would like to be admitted. If probationary lessons are necessary, your child will usually take part in probationary lessons at this school. Further information can be obtained from the respective schools (see also sections 5 and 6).


Enrollment can only be made by a parent or legal guardian or their authorized representative. As a rule, the signature of a parent or legal guardian is sufficient.

Admission

Your child is invited to attend 5th grade at the beginning of the school year at a municipal or state-run Gymnasium, Realschule or Wirtschaftsschule.

Secondary schools for university-bound students (Gymnasien)

If your child does not receive a placement at the school of your choice, the respective school administrator will make every effort to find a suitable place for your child at another Gymnasium. There is no entitlement to admission to a specific Gymnasium in Munich.

Secondary schools offering general education (Realschulen)

If your child does not receive a placement at the school of your choice, an effort will be made to find a suitable place at another public Realschule in the metropolitan area. There is no entitlement to admission to a specific Realschule in Munich.

Secondary schools focused on business and economics (Wirtschaftsschulen).

Each of the two municipal Wirtschaftsschulen offer 5th grade in the 2025–2026 school year.

Non-academic secondary schools (Mittelschulen)

The dates for pre-enrollment for certain Mittelschulen offers such as all day programs, practical classes or M-classes can be found on the homepage of the State Education Authority at www.schulamt-muenchen.musin.de as well as on the website of the respective school.

"Quota system" for admission: All children are given a chance to enroll at these schools, regardless of their grades on their 4th grade transcript in German, Math or HSU.


Allocation of places at the **municipal orientation independent of school type in Munich-Neuperlach (***städtische schulartunabhängige Orientierungsstufe*):

Group A: 60 places (20%) for students with an average grade of 1.00 to 2.33 Group B: 90 places (30%) for students with an average grade of 2.66 Group C: 90 places (30%) for students with an average grade of 3.00 and 3.33 Group D: All students who do not belong to groups A, B and C. This includes students with a grade point average of 3.66 or higher and students from state-approved schools or students from state elementary school without a transfer certificate

Allocation of places at the **municipal Willy Brandt Integrated School**: Group A: 32 places (20%) for students with an average grade of 1.00 to 2.33 Group B: 48 places (30%) for students with an average grade of 2.66 Group C: 48 places (30%) for students with an average grade of 3.00 and 3.33 Group D: 32 places (20%) for students with an average grade of 3.66 or higher

If more children are enrolled in the individual groups than there are places, a lottery will be held. It will take place at the Willy Brandt Integrated School on the day of enrollment, **Saturday, May 3, 2025**, at 3pm. The lottery at the Munich-Neuperlach Municipal Orientation independent of school type will take place on **Wednesday, May 7, 2025**, at 10am. If your child does not get a place, you can enroll them at a Gymnasium or Realschule until **Friday**, **May 9, 2025** if the transfer certificate shows the appropriate aptitude. This is also the case if you submit a hardship application after a rejection, which will only be decided on later.

Free commute to and from school



You can **apply** to have the cost of your public transport ticket (bus, streetcar, underground and suburban train) paid for.

As a rule, this applies to the school that can be reached at the lowest cost. Exceptions can be approved by the Department of Education and Sports.



- Self-assertion often remains a particular challenge for young women. All girls schools specifically support and promote a positive self-image of their students.
- Modern pedagogical concepts of mono-education allow the didactic and methodological setting of the school to be specifically geared toward acquisition of skills among girls.
- Girls discover the fascination of science more easily among themselves, as they participate more actively in lessons.
